CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Hinkle called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

SETTING OF AGENDA

Mr. Hipps requested an amendment to the agenda to include a discussion of the County Attorney's position.

Mr. Hipps made a motion, seconded by Mr. Carter, and carried with all other members present, voting yes to approve the agenda as amended, to include a discussion of the County Attorney position.

The Board discussed an available date and time for the joint meeting with Appomattox Town Council along with possible agenda items.

COUNTY ATTORNEY DISCUSSION

Board members requested that Mrs. Adams look into options for filling the County Attorney position. Mrs. Adams explained the terms of the current contract.

BUDGET WORK SESSION

The Board discussed the FY25 budget for County departments.

Mrs. Susan Walton of ACRS gave an update on ongoing ambulance issues, drug box changes by the DEA and the Virginia Board of Pharmacy, personnel wages, and the large expenses that are associated with these items.

Mr. Carter suggested that the County write a letter to state legislators concerning the upcoming drug expenses for ACRS.

Motion made by Mr. Wolfskill, seconded by Mr. Carter to fund the Appomattox County Rescue Squad in the amount of \$100,000, with \$50,000 being funded from FY24 and \$50,000 from FY25. Motion rescinded.

The Board will agreed to fund the Appomattox County Rescue Squad a total of \$150,000, with \$50,000 from FY24 and \$100,000 from FY25, but will vote on this funding at a future meeting.

The Board canceled the upcoming Budget Work Session for April 29, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.
