CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Hinkle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Motion made by Rev. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hipps to approve the agenda, as presented. Mr. Hinkle called for a roll call vote: Mr. Hipps-yes, Rev. Jones-yes, Mr. Wolfskill-yes, Mr. Carter-yes, and Mr. Hinkle-yes.

FY 2025 BUDGET DISCUSSION

Ms. Susan Adams, County Administrator, presented a PowerPoint presentation on the “Proposed” FY 2025 Budget.

Dr. Jason Tibbs, Director of Finance and Human Resources, Appomattox County Public Schools, presented an amended budget request in the amount of \$7,637,403.00 for the Schools.

Board members discussed funding options for the Appomattox County Public Schools amended budget request.

ACTION ITEMS

FY2025 Budget Approval

After being duly advertised, a Public Hearing was held on Monday, May 20, 2024, to receive public comment on the "Proposed" FY 2025 Consolidated (County, School, and Social Services) Budgets.

Motion made by Mr. Hipps, seconded by Mr. Wolfskill to approve the FY2025 Budget, as advertised. Mr. Hinkle called for a roll call vote: Mr. Carter-no, Mr. Hipps-yes, Mr. Wolfskill-yes, Rev. Jones-no, Mr. Hinkle-yes. Motion carried with a 3-2 vote.

FY 2025 Tax Levy Resolution

After being duly advertised, a Public Hearing was held on Monday, May 20, 2024, to receive public comment on the FY 2025 Tax Levies. The Board did not propose an increase in the FY 2025 Tax Levy.

APPOMATTOX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION ADOPTING FISCAL YEAR 2025 TAX LEVIES

WHEREAS, the Appomattox County Board of Supervisors wishes to adopt the following Tax Levies for Tax Year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the current Real Estate and Mobile Homes tax levy is \$0.63 per \$100 of the assessed value; and

WHEREAS, the current Personal Property tax levy on vehicles is \$3.00 per \$100 of the assessed value at 100% of the NADA clean trade-in value; and

WHEREAS, the current on all other personal property tax levy is \$3.35 per \$100 of the assessed value;

WHEREAS, the current Machinery and Tools tax levy is \$3.35 per \$100 of the assessed value at 17.3% of the initial cost; and

WHEREAS, the current Merchant's Capital tax levy is \$1.00 per \$100 of the assessed value at 85% of the original cost; and

WHEREAS, the current Vehicle License Tax is \$35.00 per vehicle

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Appomattox County Board of Supervisors adopts the aforementioned tax levies for the 2024 tax year.

ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of Appomattox County on this 29th day of May, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Hipps, seconded by Rev. Jones to adopt the FY2025 Tax Levy Resolution, as advertised. Mr. Hinkle called for a roll call vote: Mr. Carter-yes, Mr. Hipps-yes, Mr. Wolfskill-yes, Rev. Jones-yes, Mr. Hinkle-yes. Motion carried.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Mr. Carter explained that he voted "no" on the FY2025 Budget because the Board voted not to fund the American Civil War Museum. Mr. Carter explained that the taxpayer money that would have been allocated would be returned by tourists visiting the area. Mr. Carter

also shared his opinion that the Board owes the American Civil War Museum funding in order to support the organization just as the Board has funded in previous years.
