Minutes of 7 January 2025 Special Election Canvass Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:46 PM. Electoral Board (EB) members Rob DiLorenzo, Lannis Selz, and General Registrar (GR) Patricia Morton were in attendance.

The purpose of this phase of the meeting was to do a preliminary review, for completeness, of the Election Day materials in Envelope 2 from the precincts. Motion was made (Selz) and seconded (DiLorenzo) to authorize the GR and the Deputy Registrar (DR) to open the 1A envelopes on behalf of the EB.

Materials and records from all 10 Precincts (including CAP) were presented by the respective Precinct Chiefs and found to be complete.

There being no further items for discussion, the meeting was recessed at 9:20 PM by unanimous vote until 9:00 AM on Wednesday morning, at which time any citizen input on Provisional ballots will be received.

Minutes of 8 January 2025 Special Election Provisional and Canvass Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM. EB members Selz, DiLorenzo, and Haney were present, along with the GR and citizen observer Ronnie Haney. The Provisional Ballots were examined; there were 2 ballots that were part of a Same Day Registration (SDR), and one filed in place of an issued/lost absentee ballot. No citizens came forward to discuss their Provisional ballots. All Provisional ballots were approved to move forward in the process.

It was noted that 59 mail-in ballots were received on Monday 6 January; mail-in ballots will be received up until noon on the coming Friday. The Provisional part of the meeting was closed on a 3-0 vote, to be reopened at 2:30 on Friday January 10th for final disposition of Provisional ballots.

The meeting continued with the Canvass of all ballots and voting results; no discrepancies between results reporting and result tapes were found. The meeting was recessed at 11:50 AM until 3:00 PM Friday for the signing of the Abstract of Votes.

Minutes of 10 January 2024 Precinct Review Committee Meeting

The Precinct Review Committee, an ad hoc committee comprised of the EB, the GR, and Board of Supervisors members Ken Wolfskill (Appomattox River) and Al Jones (Piney Mountain) met at 9:00 AM on Friday January 10th for the purposes of reviewing voting precinct numbers and locations.

After discussion, due to the low number of voters on Election Day, along with the cost of operating separate precincts, the Committee unanimously agreed to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that the Chap and Agee precincts be combined with the Spout Spring and Oakville precincts respectively for the June 2025 primary election. The GR agreed to submit a cost comparison spreadsheet along with notes from the Committee meeting for presentation to and consideration by the full Board of Supervisors as an agenda item on their 17 January regular meeting.

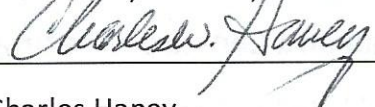
The meeting closed at 10:00 AM.

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM, with all EB members and the GR present, along with citizen observer Ronnie Haney. The Provisional Ballots were opened (by motion of Selz, seconded by DiLorenzo, with a 3-0 vote in favor), and counted by the Electoral Board.

The CAP votes were then counted by the EB and entered into the results.

The Abstract of Votes for this election was signed off at 3:00 PM, after which time the Provisional, Canvass, and Abstract meetings were closed on a unanimous vote.



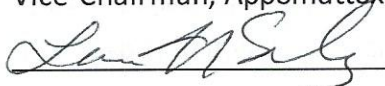
