ACTION ITEMS

2025 Tax Year Levy Resolution

After being duly advertised, a Public Hearing was held on Monday, April 21, 2025, to receive public comment on the 2025 Tax Year Levies. The Board did not propose an increase in the 2025 Tax Year Levy.

**APPOMATTOX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION ADOPTING
2025 TAX YEAR LEVIES**

WHEREAS, the Appomattox County Board of Supervisors wishes to adopt the following Tax Levies for Tax Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the current Real Estate and Mobile Homes tax levy is \$0.63 per \$100 of the assessed value; and

WHEREAS, the current Personal Property tax levy on vehicles is \$3.00 per \$100 of the assessed value at 100% of the NADA clean trade-in value; and

WHEREAS, the current on all other personal property tax levy is \$3.35 per \$100 of the assessed value;

WHEREAS, the current Machinery and Tools tax levy is \$3.35 per \$100 of the assessed value at 17.3% of the initial cost; and

WHEREAS, the current Merchant's Capital tax levy is \$1.00 per \$100 of the assessed value at 85% of the original cost; and

WHEREAS, the Data Center tax levy is \$1.00 per \$100 of the assessed value at 80% of the initial cost; and

WHEREAS, the current Vehicle License Tax is \$35.00 per vehicle

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Appomattox County Board of Supervisors adopts the aforementioned tax levies for the 2025 tax year.

ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of Appomattox County on this 30th day of April, 2025.

Motion made by Mr. Carter, seconded by Mr. Hipps to adopt the FY2025 Tax Levy Resolution, as advertised. Mr. Hinkle called for a roll call vote: Mr. Carter-yes, Mr. Hipps-yes, Mr. Wolfskill-yes, Rev. Jones-yes, Mr. Hinkle-yes. Motion carried.

FY2026 Budget Approval

After being duly advertised, a Public Hearing was held on Monday, April 21, 2025, to receive public comment on the "Proposed" FY 2026 Consolidated (County, School, and Social Services) Budgets.

The County Administrator presented a short overview of the FY2026 Proposed Budget.

Motion made by Mr. Carter, seconded by Mr. Wolfskill to approve the FY2026 Budget, as advertised. Mr. Hinkle called for a roll call vote: Mr. Carter-yes, Mr. Hipps-yes, Mr. Wolfskill-yes, Rev. Jones-yes, Mr. Hinkle-yes.

Health Insurance Update

The County Administrator discussed health insurance information that staff obtained from the Department of Human Resource Management.

Senator Luther Cifers addressed the Board to introduce himself and provide a legislative update.

Mr. Carter commented that the Central Virginia (Appomattox) area needs more attention by the state for economic development.

Mr. Hipps stated that the County should not be forced to take on solar projects. He further explained that the Board took a stance locally by changing the local zoning code. The Board has to consider the environmental issues of solar farms and the effect on the surrounding communities.

Mrs. Adams commented on the local cost for CSA program funding and rising costs due to parent referral.

Mrs. Adams commented on the return and refund of EMS funds to the County. EMS funds were frozen due to embezzlement.
