**Minutes of 4 August 2026 Electoral Board (EB) Meeting
Canvass and Provisional Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 8:12 PM. Attending were Board members Bruce Robertson, Veronica Haney, Lannis Selz, General Registrar (GR) Patricia Morton, and citizen observer Amanda Chase Scott.

The EB voted 3-0 (Motion: Selz) to delegate opening of the 1A envelopes to the GR and the Deputy Registrar (DR).

The EB reviewed the content of each precinct's #2 envelopes with the respective Precinct Chiefs for completeness of documentation, in preparation for a complete Canvass review the next day.

Motion to recess the meeting until 9:00 AM Wednesday 5 August (Robertson) was made at 9:35 pm upon completion of review, passed 3-0.

The meeting was reopened at 9:06 AM for evaluation of Provisional Votes. No voters who cast Provisional votes were present. It was noted that one (1) Provisional (SDR) ballot was received, and was approved for review (Motion Robertson, vote 3-0).

Canvass continued with a review of each precinct's data, and consistency and accuracy were checked and verified. No anomalies were found.

The meeting continued with agenda items for August. Citizen observer Amanda Chase Scott was present. The short interval between elections (August – November) raises an issue with shipping of Flash Drives to the vendor for programming, since said drives must stay in the Clerk of Court's office until August 31. A custom, expedited shipping plan will be in place.

Staffing for the November election has been reviewed; the EB agrees with the GR that we have sufficient qualified Officers of Election to be able to staff each precinct in November for an active election.

The EB agreed to complete the Americans with Disabilities Act certification and the Local Election Security plan before the August deadline.

At 12:27 PM, motion was made (Robertson), vote 3-0, to recess the Canvass meeting until Monday August 10th at 2:00.

The meeting came out of recess on Monday August 10th at 2:03 PM. The GR, and EB members Veronica Haney and Lannis Selz were present.

Staffing of OOE's for the November election was agreed upon at the following levels:

Pamplin – 7 Courthouse – 6 Oakville – 6 Spout Spring – 6 Chap – 5
Vera – 5 Moose Lodge – 6 Gleaning – 6 CAP – 5

EB member Robertson rejoined the meeting at 2:20. An emergent issue requiring discussion was raised, as the County has today communicated a plan which includes the sale of the old Oakville Ruritan building currently used as the polling place for Piney Mountain district. A search for a new polling place is to be initiated. Upgrades and modifications to OOE training were discussed based on the recent election experience.

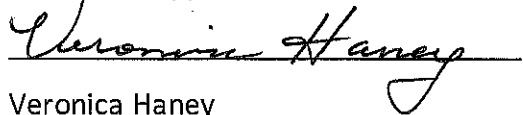
The CAP-PE (Post Election) #2 envelope was opened and the contents reviewed and determined to be complete. All remaining precinct data was final reviewed and the envelopes closed and sealed. The Canvass meeting was recessed until Tuesday August 11th at 3:00 (Motion – Robertson, vote 3-0).

The Canvass meeting came out of recess on Tuesday August 11th at 3:10 PM. The board voted 3-0 (Motion: Selz) to certify that voting precincts are in ADA compliance under Virginia law.

The Election abstracts were signed and sealed and Canvass thus certified as complete, closing out the August 4th 2026 election in Appomattox. Meeting was adjourned (Motion: Robertson) at 3:56 PM on a 3-0 vote.

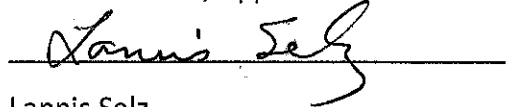
